




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
TARA provides an assessment and support service to women, over the age of 18, trafficked for commercial sexual exploitation into and across Scotland. Support can include safe accommodation, a mobile phone, clothing, basic tolletries and support to access existing mainstream services such as counseling, legal advice and healthcare.
